BIBLE STUDY CORNER

Nov 10 & 12 - No Bible Sessions (Remembrance Day)

Reflections on today's readings: "You are right, Teacher; you have truly said that 'he is one, and besides him there is no other'; and 'to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the strength,' and 'to love one's neighbor as oneself,'—this is much more important than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices." [Mk. 12:32-33]

A person who genuinely loves God also loves his fellows because they are his brothers and sisters, children of the same Father, redeemed by the same blood of our Lord Jesus Christ: "This commandment we have from Him, that he who loves God should love his brother also" (1 John 4:21). However, if we love man for man's sake without reference to God, this love will become an obstacle in keeping the first commandment, and it is no longer genuine love of our neighbour. But love of our neighbour for God's sake is clear proof that we love God: "If anyone says, 'I love God', and hates his brother, he is a liar" (1 John 4:20).
