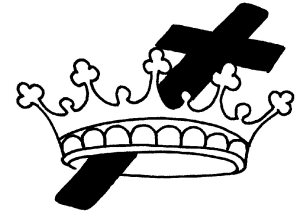

December 1 & 3 - Bible Timeline / The Gospel of Matthew
Reflections on Sunday's Readings (Dan. 7:14): *To him was given dominion and glory and kingship, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship is one that shall never be destroyed.* When the Church proclaims in the Creed that Christ is seated at the right hand of the Father, she is saying it was to Christ dominion was given; "Being seated at the Father's right hand signifies the inauguration of the Messiah's kingdom, the fulfillment of the prophet Daniel's vision concerning the Son of man (Dan. 7:14). After this event the apostles became witnesses of the 'kingdom [that] will have no end' (Nicene Creed)" ("Catechism of the Catholic Church", 664).
