Weekday Masses During Lent

Monday - Friday: 8:15am and 7:30pm
EXCEPT March 16 - 27 (Spring Break):
8am & 7:30pm

All Fridays: Stations of the Cross at 7:00pm
& Mass at 7:30pm (*No Divine Mercy during Lent*)

All Saturdays: 9:00am

Fasting Days includes Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (one full meatless meal is permitted), and meatless Fridays during Lent (seafood permitted).

The Three Pillars of Lent are *prayer, fasting, and almsgiving*. In addition of fasting, you may also choose to abstain from other comforts during Lent.

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday, March 28 - 29, a celebration of Christ's triumphal return to Jerusalem.

Easter Triduum begins with Holy Thursday, April 2, at sunset, to Saturday, April 4, at sunset.

Thursday: **No morning Mass**
MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER - 7:30PM

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT
Will be closed at 10pm on this day & will be open after Paschal Vigil on Saturday.

Good Friday: **Stations of the Cross for Children - 11:00AM**
CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION - 2:00PM & 5:00PM

Holy Saturday: **PASCHAL VIGIL - 9:00PM (No 5:00PM Mass)**
This service, consisting of Service of Light, Liturgy of the Word, Baptismal Liturgy, and Holy Eucharist, will last at least 2 1/2 hours. It is the most beautiful service of the year, and we encourage you to come, but because of the length it would be wiser not to bring small children.
